


Research Fellowship Program

3 - 6 months (from October, 2022 onwards)

Of the Residential Research Fellowship:

 Completed Application form with a covering letter; in addition: detailed CV (viz. academic performance, publications, social-work/professional experience); testimonials by 2 referees; research proposal (max. 3000 words)

Health insurance coverage

- Free accommodation and full board (vegetarian food): on campus (smoking and alcohol consumption prohibited), shared or single occupancy apartment with attached bathroom and toilet
- Free access to library, archival and other resources
- Local travel support for field work, if required
- The Research Fellow is expected to hold a seminar/lecture on research topic; submit research results for peer review and GRF publication.
