Terms & Conditions

I. About the content:

- Each participant can submit only one video speech for the contest;
- Duration, four minutes maximum;
- The video can be shot using a mobile or any other camera;
- Video orientation should be horizontal;
- The participant can speak in one of the three languages: Marathi or Hindi or English. Mixing languages is not allowed;
- The presentation should start with the following introduction: "I am.....(name)..... resident of (village/city, District and state), studying(standard)..... at (school/college)..... happy to be a part of the online elocution competition conducted by the Gandhi Research Foundation on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti 2023, would like to speak on(theme)....."
- The speech must be confined to the theme. Wrong or controversial information would invite disqualification;
- The candidate should not read a written message, but speak directly to the camera;
- The speaker should be clearly visible in the video, the audio must be clear and without any disruption;

- The video must be newly recorded exclusively for this competition. It should not have been submitted for any other competition or event nor have been already published;
- Once your video is ready, then fill your online registration on <https://forms.gle/facmSqHUjoBdsEcC6>

II. Registration and submission:

- Online registration form should be uploaded with complete information along with 1 ID proof – (any one of the Gov approved identity documents such as: Aadhar card, Passport, etc.) or Institution Identity Card
- Last date for submission of the videos is: 15.09.2023 (including the first level of the third group)

III. Selection Process:

- The submitted videos will be evaluated by a Jury panel appointed by the GRF;
- The final winners will be selected on the basis of 'likes' received by the video as well as the scores given by the examiners. (90% marks obtained by Juries and 10% marks for social media)
- The official link for each video will be sent to the respective candidates for their online campaign in seeking 'likes' and comments;

- Third group (college group) Second round the selected participants from the first phase will have to express their views on the subjects of the extempore competition on September 26, 2023 in the premises of Gandhi Research Foundation Institute and are also expected to answer the questions of the examiners.
- The final results will be declared on 02/10/2023, published on www.gandhifoundation.net

IV. Honours

- All participants will receive an online certificate of participation;
- The prize money will be credited to the winning candidates' bank account.

V. Statutory

- The Jury's decision will be final;
- The GRF holds the right to publish the videos in their other media in future;
- The registered candidates are considered to have agreed to the terms and conditions of the contest;
- The GRF can exercise its discretion in adjusting the norms and pattern of the contest, if required.
