Quarter II (Three months - Nov. - Jan.)

Practicals :

Three months campus training, hand on experience, TOC and Project proposal; field practicals on community organization, reconstruction technological exposure

Quarter III (Three months - Feb. - Apr.)

NGO internship :

Front-line campuses that offer pioneering leadership on sustainable rural reconstruction

Quarter IV (Three months - May - Jul.)

Rural placement :

In selected villages; organizing people for sustainable development initiatives

Terms :

- ▶ Candidates are to commit themselves to work for Sustainable Rural Reconstruction
- ▶ Only those completed the first quarter successfully will be admitted to subsequent quarters.

- Second quarter : Hands-on experiencing, classroom sessions, field practicals, technological exposures, assignments, yoga and prayer
